




Supply (Jobs)

Demand (Job Postings)


Competition from online job postings is low in Frederick County, MD. The national average for an area this size is 53* job postings/mo, while there are 39 here.


Supply Is Higher Than the National Average





Racial Diversity


Racial diversity is low in Frederick County, MD. The national average for an area this size is 3,689* racially diverse employees, while there are 3,144 here.

Unemployment shown at the 2-digit sector level.





Industry Age Breakdown




Industry Race/Ethnicity Breakdown






Industry Gender Breakdown



Top 15 Skills for All Job Types by Quarter


